Below are two more meatless recipes for your enjoyment:

Fettuccini Alfredo

1 oz. pkg. cream cheese, cut into cubes and softened at room temp.

3/4 cup (3 oz.) freshly grated Parmesan Reggiano cheese

1/2 cup butter, softened

1 cup whipping cream

8 oz. favorite fettuccini, a la dente

In large saucepan, combine cream cheese, Parmesan Reggiano cheese, butter and cream. Stir over low heat, until all ingredients are combined. Toss over cooked pasta and serve. Top with fresh parsley or extra parmesan cheese. If you like a thinner sauce, add more cream or milk. Serve with bread and salad. Serves 4.

Beth Kouche's Black Bean Chili

10-11 oz. frozen corn (no sauce)

2 Tbsp. olive oil

1 onion, minced

2 tsp. ground cumin

1 Tbsp. chili powder

1 can chicken broth

2 cans black beans, drained

2 cans diced tomatoes

2 - 4 oz. cans green chilies

1 can jalapenos (optional)

Garnishes: sour cream

shredded sharp cheddar cheese

Prep time about 20 minutes.

Either put all ingredients in crock pot and cook for 8 hours or follow the following directions. Preheat oven to 400 degrees. Put corn on cookie sheet. Add 1 Tbsp. olive oil and stir to coat the corn. Bake about 20 minutes until brown, stirring once half way through time. While corn is cooking in oven, cook onion in other 1 Tbsp. of oil in saucepan until softened (about 5 min.). Add cumin and chili powder stirring constantly for 1 minute. Stir in broth, beans, tomatoes, and chilies. Reduce to medium heat and cover (15 minutes). Stir in corn. Serve with sour cream or cheddar cheese.
