PASTOR'S CORNER

Not everyone can take advantage of all the good things life affords. But don't cheat yourself needlessly. The liturgy of the three days of Holy Week is one of the good things of life. Do you hunger for more? Bring that to the table of the Last Supper. Are you broken? Join that to the brokenness of the Lord. Do you yearn for an intervention in your life? Celebrate the in-breaking of the one who breaks into the sentence of death in order to bring new life.

Thursday evening we celebrate the Mass of Lord's Supper. At this Mass Fr. Manuel and I will invite anyone who cares to, to come forward and have his/her feet washed in a reenactment of the Last Supper. During this liturgy the Holy Oils blessed by Archbishop Pilarczyk on Tuesday will be presented. (Incidentally, I would encourage you to attend that Mass at the Cathedral at 7:30 PM.) The liturgy concludes in silence after a special procession and reverence for the Holy Eucharist.

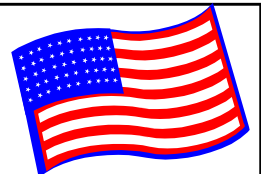
On Good Friday the church will be open until 3:00 pm. We will celebrate the Good Friday Liturgy at 1:00. This Liturgy has four parts. The scriptures include the proclamation of the Passion according to St. John. Special intercessory prayers, a procession and reverence of the cross, and a communion rite follow that.

In the last year, have you experienced the baptism of a baby or the Christian burial of a loved one? If you've celebrated these mysteries of birth and death recently, I especially encourage you to attend the Easter Vigil this year. The symbols of light and water come from this, the most important Mass of the year. Since candidates and catechumens receive the sacraments of initiation at this Mass, it has also become like an anniversary for others through the years who were welcomed into the Church at this time.
