## PASTOR'S CORNER

This weekend we're happy to welcome Janet Poulin to St. Julie Billiart as our new Liturgical Music Director. As you'll read elsewhere in today's bulletin, Janet brings a wealth of ability, experience, and enthusiasm. I know our liturgical prayer will be enriched by her ministry. The U.S. Bishops' document entitled "Sing to the Lord" begins:

God has bestowed upon his people the gift of song. God dwells within each human person, in the place where music takes its source. Indeed, God, the giver of song, is present whenever his people sing his praises.

A cry from deep within our being, music is a way for God to lead us to the realm of higher things. As St. Augustine says, "Singing is for the one who loves." Music is therefore a sign of God's love for us and of our love for him. In this sense, it is very personal. But unless music sounds, it is not music, and whenever it sounds, it is accessible to others. By its very nature song has both an individual and a

communal dimension. Thus, it is no wonder that singing together in church expresses so well the sacramental presence of God to his people.

Just for this weekend we welcome Fr. Gracioso Charcos from the Missionaries of Jesus. Welcoming a missionary each year helps remind us that we are part of the Universal Church, not just a local parish, or even a Diocese. Fr. Charcos is speaking to us about his work in the Philippines: physically far away, but still a part of who we are.

Next weekend at the 8:30 Mass we will confirm Tom DiNuoscio and Adam Robbins. These two men were baptized and raised Catholic, but never Confirmed. At the beginning of the summer they attended Sr. André's "What Do Catholics Believe?" sessions and are seeking to reinvigorate their relationship with the Lord and the Church through the special gift of the Holy Spirit.

### Archdiocesan Trip to Mexico

The Mission Office of the Cincinnati Archdiocese occasionally sponsors tours to other countries to enable participants to experience, first-hand, the culture and the spirituality of other countries. One such excursion, coming up in December, will visit Mexico City and the coastal area of Puerto Escondido. This is the diocese of Bishop Eduardo Carmona whom some may remember as having visited with us here at St. Julie's.

Two tour options are available: Plan A – December 11-18, will visit Huatulco and Puerto Escondido to share in the celebration of the local religious festivals, and to enjoy the beautiful beaches and tourist sites. Plan B – December 8-10, will start in Mexico City to visit the world famous Basilica of Guadalupe and the museums of Anthropology and the Fine Arts, before joining the other tour group in Puerto Escondido.
