Easter Sunday is a great day for us each year. Not only do we celebrate the central Mystery of our salvation, but we have the opportunity to welcome people who are not with us most Sundays. Instead of asking them, "Where have you been?" we can ask, "How can we help you feel like you'd like to come back?" Evangelization does not always mean standing on a street corner preaching. It can mean letting folks know we are glad to see them.

That attitude gives us a focus for our Masses next weekend. So in addition to saying hello to the regulars, please greet people you think you may never have seen before. You don't have to say, "Welcome to St. Julie," after all they may be here every week and just switched Masses for Easter. Just say, "Happy Easter" and acknowledge them in some way. If you see someone who appears a little lost, ask if you can help. If the usher needs a hand please do so. We want to make sure that everyone goes away with a bulletin.

I guess the bottom line is that, if we believe that Easter is the celebration of Christ's victory over sin and death, if we believe that his love is without end, if we believe that around the Word and Sacrament we find fulfillment, let's hope that our attitude reflects that. I will pray for that grace for myself and for all of us.

The Ancient Office of Tenebrae, Wednesday of Holy Week, March 31st, at 7:30 PM, at St. Peter in Chains Cathedral in Cincinnati.

Latin for "darkness" is a special holy week liturgy featuring passion-tide music spanning medieval through twentieth century chant and polyphony including Gregorio Allegri's sublime setting of Psalm 51, *Miserere* sung by the cathedral choir. The mood of the service is somewhat somber, quiet and reflective; its dramatic features are the gradual extinction of a fifteen branch candelabra in the center of the sanctuary, and the church contemplates the temporary triumph of the prince of darkness over the world, and a loud noise at its conclusion, suggesting the earthquake described in the passion narratives. No admission charge for the Tenebrae Service ~ because of the nature of this service, it is not recommended for children and infants.
