Part of being Pro-life is to affirm pro-life decisions. This is difficult for a family when a young, unmarried member of the family becomes pregnant. I suggest to family members that the ideal first response to the news is: "Thank you for choosing life." It is so easy for a frightened young woman to do otherwise. That is not to say we agree with the first decision she made. We do affirm the second.

What else do we have to offer? Catholic Charities has a whole program to support women in their decision whether to raise the child herself or allow the child to be adopted by someone else who is able to provide what the woman, herself, would want to provide but cannot at

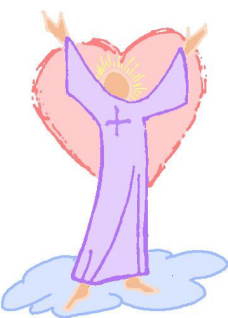

Dove House operates two protective shelters in Butler County, Ohio, one in Hamilton and one in Middletown. In addition, Dove House provides a 24-hour crisis hotline, advocacy for victims, training to increase self-sufficiency, and a survivors' support group. Dove House provides educational and outreach programs to both educate the community about the cycle of domestic violence and to give victims the support and courage to seek help.

**FIFTH ANNIVERSARY OF THE MARTYRDOM OF SISTER DOROTHY STANG**

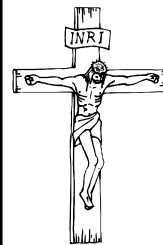

### Did You Know?

#### Five Steps to Safer Environments

The archdiocese mandates that all people who work with children and youth in our parishes and schools must undergo child abuse prevention training through the VIRTUS program. The training details five steps to prevent child sexual abuse: Know the warning signs of an inappropriate relationship with a child.

1. Know the warning signs!
2. Control access to children by carefully selecting the adults who work with children and youth.
3. Monitor all programs for the safety of children and youth.
4. Be aware of and sensitive to what is going on in the lives of children.
5. Communicate concerns to the appropriate person in authority.
