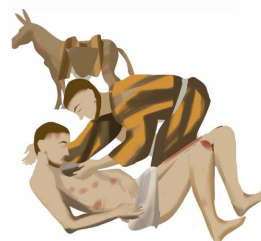
For many years the Church did not approve cremation of a Catholic because it was, for some non-believers, a way of symbolically denying the resurrection of the body. It was not a doctrinal position, but one of practice. Since cremation is no longer generally seen as a denial of the Resurrection, cremation, it is now permitted.

While cremation is permitted, the Church clearly prefers and urges that the body of the deceased be present for the funeral rites, since the presence of the human body better expresses the values which the Church affirms in those rites" (Order of Christian Funerals, par. 413). "Moreover, the body which lies in death naturally recalls the personal story of faith, the loving family bonds, the friendships, and the words and acts of kindness of the deceased person (par. 412)."

If, for some reason, a family chooses cremation, the preference is to have the body present at the Funeral Liturgy, with cremation following. However, it is possible to have a

Funeral Liturgy with the cremated remains present. Naturally a worthy vessel is to be used. "The cremated remains should be buried in a grave or entombed in a mausoleum or columbarium. The practice of scattering cremated remains on the sea, from the air, or on the ground, or keeping cremated remains in the home of a relative or friend of the deceased is not the reverent disposition the Church requires (par. 417)."

Our two Catholic cemeteries, St. Stephen and St. Mary, have niches to properly respect the earthly remains of those who are cremated.

This event is a fundraiser for the 4th floor renovation project.

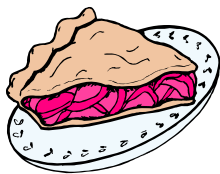
