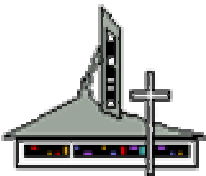

IS YOUR MARRIAGE HURTING IN ANY WAY?

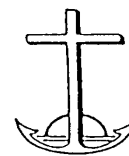
