Reflecting on this verse last week I talked about buying FAIR TRADE articles and foods. I didn't want to take too much time but wanted to start introducing the concept. A good place to get more information is from Catholic Relief Services www.crsfairtrade.org. There you'll find that the Fair Trade movement is first, and most importantly, about building relationships. You'll find that that Fair Trade embodies a comprehensive set of criteria, including, at minimum, the following commitments:

- Paying a **fair wage** in the local context
- Offering employees **opportunities for advancement**
- Providing **equal employment opportunities** for all people, particularly the most disadvantaged
- Engaging in **environmentally sustainable practices**
- Being open to **public accountability**
- Building **long-term trade relationships**
- Providing **healthy and safe working conditions** within the local context
- Providing **financial and technical assistance** to producers whenever possible
